Top tip: transmitter carrying case

We all know that it's important to protect our transmitters. The switches are particularly prone to damage. Aluminium cases are often expensive. However on eBay you can buy a foam lined aluminium case for about £20. They are called variously flight case, camera case or microphone case. The foam filling is in loosely connected sections that can be torn away to form the spaces for the transmitter and other bits. The ones I bought had a foam lining in the lid but not in the base, so I cut a piece of felt to fit. Mine was a piece left over from loudspeaker building but any decent foam would do. You can get various sizes but mine are 300 x 240 x 125 mm, which are compact but big enough. The pictures tell it all:
