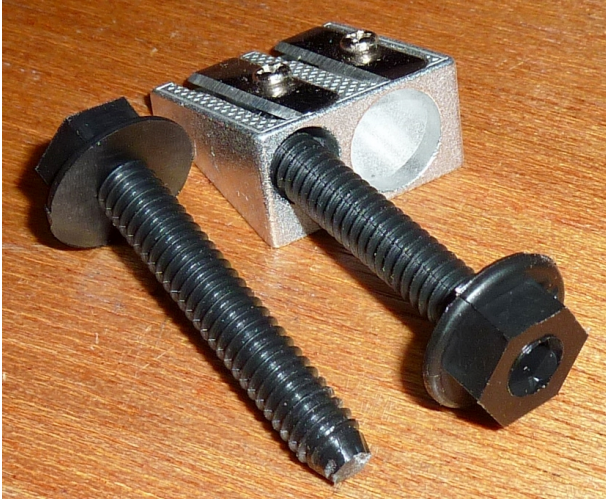


Top tip: Trimming plastic screws

The only thing I don't like about Wot models are the wing screws. They are all 1/4" x 20 unified. The ones supplied with my Wot4 were too long and no-one now sells shorter ones as they have been replaced with M6 long ago. When cutting nylon screws I have found it difficult to clean off the rough edges that could jam in the thread. Chatting with Mick Spencer about it he suggested I use a pencil sharpener. Stroke of genius. After cutting to length with a hacksaw, and filing the end smooth and flat, I turned the screws a few times in the sharpener until the threads were clear. They fitted smoothly and perfectly. And here they are:



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
